Apple Day

UNESCO 72d birthday

UNESCO 72d Birthday was marked with the series of school radio broadcasts about UNESCO history and present day activities. Students studied 17 basic goals to be achieved by 2030 by making a posters' installation.

Human Rights Day

Traditionally, 10th December is the day to speak about the basic rights all people should have. In NVRK this day was marked with the study of "Universal Declaration of Human Rights" in 9-12 forms. Students got information about those from posters on the school building walls, doing kahoot.com activities and discussing the most important with the school volunteer Sergen Bahmal from Turkey.

World Cancer Day

On 4th February upper-secondary students had lessons devoted to World Cancer Day. During the lessons they studied the cancer statistics doing the running dictation. Then during the Documentary Film Club session students watched the real story of a person who fought the disease but died of that. This true story made students be deep in fought about the global problem of cancer.

International Days of Water, Forest and Earth

In March the weeks of foreign and Russian languages dedicated to the Days of Water, Forest, Earth and the 100th anniversary of Estonia were held in NVRK. 3-4 form drew pictures for the exhibition of drawings depicting the plants and birds of Estonia. Pictures were signed in two languages - Russian and English. 8-9 forms took part in the Digi-quiz that presented questions about prominent facts and the 100th anniversary of Estonia. On 21st March - Forest Day – there was a radio broadcast with the sounds of the forest. It let students and teachers feel as if deep in the woods. On 22d March- Water Day – there was a musical flash mob “Water”. Each class sang the song “Water” at 9.00. A signal to the beginning was given in the radio broadcast. The link was sent to teachers through ekool. On 23d March Fedyukhina A. gave an open lesson “Oceans” in 7th grade. The same day there was a session of the Documentary Film Club for the students of 10- 12 forms devoted to the topic “Forests”. The documentary let students study information about the amount of forests on the planet. To follow, students played a Kahoot game to check their knowledge. On 27 March 9-12 forms gathered in the assembly hall for the Blitz Competition "The best signature for a photo". On March 19-29, pupils of grades 5-7 watched films about Earth and space in the planetarium.
